The Core Issue (Judges 14)

I Want It!

Samson went down to Timnah and saw there a young Philistine woman. When he returned, he said to his father and mother, "I have seen a Philistine woman in Timnah; now get her for me as my wife."

Judges 14:1

I Want It!

Samson saw and Samson desired We All See Where do you go from there? Seeing becomes desire Desire becomes lust

Samson Didn't Think it Through

Samson did not consider how it would impact his mission.

Samson did not care what others thought

He did not consult God's word (Deuteronomy 7:3-4)

Deserve It!

Some time later, when he went back to marry her, he turned aside to look at the lion's carcass, and in it he saw a swarm of bees and some honey. He scooped out the honey with his hands and ate as he went along. When he rejoined his parents, he gave them some, and they too ate it. But he did not tell them that he had taken the honey from the lion's carcass.

Judges 14:8-9

I Deserve It!

On his way it says he turned aside

When he arrives and the lion carcass is still there

Bees have built a nest and are making honey

Samson decides to eat....

What was he thinking?

What did he forget?

That's disgusting!

He did not kill the lion How do you survive a lion attack?

His Commitment (Nazirite of God)

Throughout the period of their dedication to the Lord, the Nazirite must not go near a dead body

Numbers 6:6

I Can Handle It!

Now his father went down to see the woman. And there Samson held a feast, as was customary for young men.

Judges 14:10

Can Handle It!

It's all because of the desire at the beginning

If he had not acted out his lust he would not be in this situation

> There would be no reason for him to be here

No Lion

No Honey No "Feast"

I Can Handle It!

The drinking led to bad influences (v. 11)

The bad influences led to boasting and betting (v. 12-14)

The boasting and betting led to being manipulated (v. 15-17)

The manipulation led to being in debt (v. 18)

Being in debt led to murder and theft (v. 19)

Murder and theft led to him loosing his wife (v. 20)

Samson thought he could handle his sin and until it was too late he never understood his sin had a hold on him.
