Samson threw the party Samson made the bet


Samson created the arrogant riddle

So they killed his wife whom he left, so he went on a rampage


"Since you've acted like this, I swear that I won't stop until I get my revenge on you."

Samson won... or did he?




Revenge is Never the Answer
