He's Peter!

He was a married man (Mark 1:30)

He was the "ROCK"

He preached the first ever church sermon (Acts 2:14-41)

He was technically the first missionary (Acts 10)

He was the first one to confess Christ (Matthew 16:16)

He was the first leader of the church in Jerusalem (Acts 5:29)





EXTREMELY CONFIDENT BUT NEVER SURE

- He's the guy that was constantly correcting Jesus
- He's the guy that declared to go to the grave with Jesus, only to later deny him
- He's the guy that cut off a man's ear only to disappear into the night
- He's the guy that refused to be washed only to demand to be bathed
 - He's the guy that stepped out of the boat only to sink like a "rock"



HIS "MOMENT" OF DOUBT

Peter's great confidence often led him down the path of doubt

There was not a moment of doubt, there were many moments for him



A M/ALK M/T-I PETER - MATT-IEM 14:25-31

Shortly before dawn Jesus went out to them, walking on the lake. When the disciples saw him walking on the lake, they were terrified. "It's a ghost," they said, and cried out in fear. But Jesus immediately said to them: "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid." "Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water." "Come," he said. Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus. But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!" Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?"

The story of Jesus walking on water is told here and in Mark and John

Interesting only Matthew mentions Peter getting out of the boat

This is a story of phenomenal faith that reminds us that confidence and doubt go hand in hand

The first words spoken by Jesus in the story are

"Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid."



DOUBTERS WELCOME.

LORD SAVE ME

Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him.

He did not let Peter thrash about is his doubt

He did not laugh at his lost confidence

Jesus would use this moment to teach him a lesson





DEALING WITH PETERS DOUBT

"You of little faith," he said, "Why did you doubt?"

He told Peter he had little faith

That is not the same as saying he had no faith

Peter's Little faith gave him the confidence to get out of the boat

Great faith would have allowed him to stay out





"There is room to grow, don't give up"





"\n/-IY DID YOU DOUBT?"

Jesus knows Peter, he will beat himself up over this

He is probably embarrassed







"MAT CHANGED?"

It was his focus

When Jesus was the focal point all was good

When the wind and waves became the focal point, fear and sinking

He's Peter, how long to you want this sermon to be?

The Bible never tells us he got a do over

All the times he went back on a boat I personally believe Peter looked out at the water and said "next time"

I often wonder in private moments if placed his feet in the water and asked the question of himself the question again; "why did I doubt"





-IS CONTRIBUTIONS

Later in life Peter would have to take another faith walk

It would be a walk far more challenging than his few steps on the water

Very truly I tell you, when you were younger you dressed yourself and went where you wanted; but when you are old you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will dress you and lead you where you do not want to go." Jesus said this to indicate the kind of death by which Peter would glorify God. Then he said to him, "Follow me!"

John 21:18-19



IIS CONTRIBUTIONS

On that day as Peter himself was being led to be crucified I wonder if he thought back to the water

All the times he went back on a boat I personally believe Peter looked out at the water and said "next time"

Not this time... This time Jesus I won't flinch...
I will not look away

History tells us he confidently requested to be crucified upside down because he did not feel worthy to die the same way Jesus did

Stepping Out is easy, walking confidently not so much
