Stanza One -- Psalm 42:1-4

As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for you, my God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When can I go and meet with God? My tears have been my food day and night, while people say to me all day long, "Where is your God?" These things I remember as I pour out my soul: how I used to go to the house of God under the protection of the Mighty One with shouts of joy and praise among the festive throng.

The Need for God

The psalmist compares his need for relationship with God to water

He says his soul is thirsty

He does not know where to find God

He is dealing with sorrow while the people around him are asking where is your God now



The Need for God

He sits on the hill of despair he remembers back to a time when God was close

There was a time when his soul felt connected to

God

He used to go to God's house

He used to feel safe in God

His soul used to shout and praise

Stanza Two-Psalm 42:6-10

My soul is downcast within me; therefore, I will remember you from the land of the Jordan, the heights of Hermon from Mount Mizar. Deep calls to deep in the roar of your waterfalls; all your waves and breakers have swept over me. By day the Lord directs his love, at night his song is with me— a prayer to the God of my life. I say to God my Rock, "Why have you forgotten me? Why must I go about mourning, oppressed by the enemy?" My bones suffer mortal agony as my foes taunt me, saying to me all day long, "Where is your God?"

Up the Hill

Stanza one started with thirst, stanza two starts with the answer; water

The land of Jordan: Is a symbol of freedom

His thirst has been answered not with Drops but with waves that wash over him

He sees God as love and life



It Does not Last

He acknowledges God as the foundation but follows it with, where are you?

As he plummets down the hill he feels forgotten

He uses words like mourning, oppressed, and agony

He is overwhelmed by his enemies

Stanza Three -- Psalm 43:1-4

Vindicate me, my God, and plead my cause against an unfaithful nation. Rescue me from those who are deceitful and wicked. You are God my stronghold. Why have you rejected me? Why must I go about mourning, oppressed by the enemy? Send me your light and your faithful care, let them lead me; let them bring me to your holy mountain, to the place where you dwell. Then I will go to the altar of God, to God, my joy and my delight. I will praise you with the lyre, O God, my God.
