
A Chowing Community

Community Killers

What is Malice?

Desire to cause pain, injury, or distress to another

Intent to commit an unlawful act or cause harm without legal justification or excuse

When you look at the definitions, malice is an internal issue





Malice is Reactive

"This is what the Sovereign Lord says: 'Because the Philistines acted in vengeance and took revenge with malice in their hearts, and with ancient hostility sought to destroy Judah."

Ezekiel 25:15



Notice while the outward action is revenge, the inward thought is malice

What are the effects of Malice?

Vicious Speech (Psalm 5:9) Abusive (Psalm 55:10)

Oppressive and Arrogant (Psalm 73:8)

"You have heard that it was said to the people long ago,
'You shall not murder, and anyone who murders will subject to
judgment.' But I tell you that anyone who is angry with a
brother or sister will be subject to judgment. Again,
anyone who says to a brother or sister, 'Raca,' is
answerable to the court. And anyone who
says, 'You fool!' will be in danger
of the fire of hell.

Therefore, each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to your neighbor, for we are all members of one body. "In your anger do not sin": Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, and do not give the devil a foothold.

We are holding onto things and building barriers


Dealing With Malice

Seek Resolution

For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me." In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

So then, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. Everyone ought to examine themselves before they eat of the bread and drink from the cup. For those who eat and drink without discerning the body of Christ eat and drink judgment on themselves. That is why many among you are weak and sick, and a number of you have fallen asleep. But if we were more discerning with regard to ourselves, we would not come under such judgment.
