


## Ephesians 5:25-30

The fact we see them connecting together should give support to the fact they are demonstratable acts of faith






## About Jesus






## Repent (the Vows)

And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.



## Baptism (The Rings)








Am J Saved? If all I do is confess/profess Jesus says many will try that route and none will succeed unless you know Him (Matthew 7:21)






**Baptism**Its a pledge and thus can not be dismissed as an after thought, a work or a trivial option that I do if I feel like it







