

A Conflicted Worldview

68% who consider themselves to be Christians claim to have a Biblical worldview, yet only 9% do

69% of adults who attend a mainline Protestant church claim they have a biblical worldview 8% actually have one

31% of adults say it is very important for their religious faith to influence every dimension of their life

A Conflicted Worldview

29% believe that the best indicator of success in life is consistent obedience to God

33% believe that human beings are born with a sinful nature and can only be saved from the consequences of sin by Jesus Christ

47% believe that when they die they will go to Heaven only because they have confessed their sins and have accepted Jesus Christ as their savior

Biblical Morkdview Benefit 2: Not be Led Astray

Timothy, guard what has been entrusted to your care. Turn away from godless chatter and the opposing ideas of what is falsely called knowledge, which some have professed and in so doing have departed from the faith.
