

Brand New King

The kingdom is now being ran by Belshazzar

From a Biblical standpoint this is his only scene

From the Bible we do know he reigned for at least three years (Daniel 8:1)

We also know he was the last king of Babylon and it fell around 539BC

While he is a new King, he is still a pagan king

Same Old Story

So, they brought in the gold goblets that had been taken from the temple of God in Jerusalem, and the king and his nobles, his wives and his concubines drank from them. As they drank the wine, they praised the gods of gold and silver, of bronze, iron, wood and stone.

Daniel 5:3-4

Same Old Story

Remember King Nebuchadnezzar took Jerusalem (586 BC)

He destroy the temple.

He laid claim to their religion (Daniel 1:2)

At this point Daniel has been in Babylon for around 50 years.

Jewish tradition place his birth around 620 BC

He has spent more time in Babylon then in Jerusalem.

The Writing on the Wall (Daniel 5:5-9)

The Writing on the Wall

In the middle of their party God shows up

He literally writes a message on the wall

Baffled: totally bewilder or perplex

When the world sees God's message often it makes no sense them (1 Corinthians 2:14)

Jewish tradition place his birth around 620 BC

He has spent more time in Babylon then in Jerusalem.



Remember Daniel Daniel 5:10-12

It appears that through the swapping of kings Daniel sort of fell off the radar

He's in nearing his eighties maybe he decided to retire

Another great lesson, with God there is no such thing as retirement

The Queen remembers the stories and tells the king

Daniel is summoned before the king

Now I have heard that you are able to give interpretations and to solve difficult problems. If you can read this writing and tell me what it means, you will be clothed in purple and have a gold chain placed around your neck, and you will be made the third highest ruler in the kingdom. Then Daniel answered the king, You may keep your gifts for yourself and give your rewards to someone else. Nevertheless, I will read the writing for the king and tell him what it means.

Ting Meet Daniel

When Daniel arrives, the king offers him a little flattery

He also offers him a reward

Daniel says keep it; I don't want anything from you

Before we read Daniel's sermon I want to step into his mind for a moment

This would be Daniel's worst nightmare come true and now he must speak for God

GOOF: 133333 33333 (Daniel 5:v. 18-28)

The Sermon

He addresses him with respect: Your Majesty

God is in control

God humbled your father

You chose to disgrace God

God has spoken: Your Days are Numbered



The Sermon

Mene: God has numbered the days of your reign and brought it to an end. Mene Mene Tekel Parsin

Tekel: You have been weighed on the scales and found wanting.

Parsin: Your kingdom is divided and given to the Medes and Persians.

Mocked by Man Vindicated by God

Then at Belshazzar's command, Daniel was clothed in purple, a gold chain was placed around his neck, and he was proclaimed the third highest ruler in the kingdom.

Mocked by Man Vindicated by God

Many would say Daniel was honored

In the king's arrogance he did exactly what Daniel said he did not want

He dressed him up

He was given a promotion in the kingdom



Mene Mene Tekel Do you think he Parsin really took what Daniel said seriously?

Mocked by Man Vindicated by God

That very night Belshazzar, king of the Babylonians, was slain, and Darius the Mede took over the kingdom, at the age of sixty-two.
