The Book of Zechariah

He is writing and ministering to the remnant that returned from captivity

The project of rebuilding the temple is now underway

His concern is not the rebuilding process itself, but the people who are rebuilding

These people had been raised in a foreign land and needed to be reacquainted with their God

God Is Sovereign

From chapter 1:7 to chapter 6:8, Zechariah records a series of eight visions

Many of these visions have been associated with “end-time” prophecies

The eight-night visions reveal that God is aware, active, and just

From horses patrolling the earth to the cleansing of Joshua the high priest, every vision points to one truth: God is working behind the scenes

The Object Lesson

Zechariah is told to make a crown for the high priest,

Tell him this is what the Lord Almighty says: “Here is the man whose name is the Branch, and he will branch out from his place and build the temple of the Lord. It is he who will build the temple of the Lord, and he will be clothed with majesty and will sit and rule on his throne. And he will be a priest on his throne. And there will be harmony between the two.”

Zechariah 6:12–13

Jesus King and Priest

Because of this oath, Jesus has become the guarantor of a better covenant. Now there have been many of those priests, since death prevented them from continuing in office; but because Jesus lives forever, he has a permanent priesthood. Therefore, he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them. Such a high priest truly meets our need—one who is holy, blameless, pure, set apart from sinners, exalted above the heavens.

The Promise of Messiah

The crown will be given to Heldai, Tobijah, Jedaiah, and Hen son of Zephaniah as a memorial in the temple of the Lord. Those who are far away will come and help to build the temple of the Lord, and you will know that the Lord Almighty has sent me to you. This will happen if you diligently obey the Lord your God.”

The Promise of Messiah

The physical temple building was not the subject, just as Jesus was not speaking of that when he spoke in ***John 2:19-21***

On day three Jesus came roaring out of that tomb and through his death, burial and resurrection a “new” temple was indeed built from people far and wide made up of all who have chosen to follow (***1 Corinthians 6:19–20***)

The Easter Prophet

If Micah is your “Christmas Prophet,” Zechariah is your “Easter Prophet.”

Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion! Shout, Daughter Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and victorious, lowly and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

The Easter Prophet

He foretells the betrayal—the thirty pieces of silver and the potter's field (**Zechariah 11:12–13**)

He speaks of a Shepherd who will be pierced (**Zechariah 12:10**)

He describes the scattering of the sheep (**Zechariah 13:7**)

The Day of the Lord

He describes the ultimate Day of Cleansing and Renewal (**Zechariah 14:6–9**)

Major Insight

He assures us that our hope is not in governments or personal strength—it's in King Jesus

Today, we live between redemption and consummation. The King has come, and He will come again

“The Lord was very angry with your ancestors. Therefore, tell the people: This is what the Lord Almighty says: ‘Return to me,’ declares the Lord Almighty, ‘and I will return to you,’ says the Lord Almighty. Do not be like your ancestors, to whom the earlier prophets proclaimed: This is what the Lord Almighty says: ‘Turn from your evil ways and your evil practices.’ But they would not listen or pay attention to me, declares the Lord. Where are your ancestors now? And the prophets, do they live forever? But did not my words and my decrees, which I commanded my servants the prophets, overtake your ancestors?”

A Loving Plea

God opens with a heartfelt call: “Return to Me.”

The people had returned to the land and resumed their mission, but God wanted more than activity; He wanted their hearts

And for hearts to return means repentance

Repentance is not about shame—it’s about restoration

God’s call is still the same today—no matter how far we drift, He invites us back

Learn from the Past

The people are warned not to be like their ancestors, who ignored the prophets

God is saying, “Don’t repeat their mistakes; there’s a better way—heed My words, follow My commands.”

Know that I am just in My dealings—willing and eager to show mercy but also willing to pass judgment

Return to Me, and I will be your God, and you will be My people
